

# ABOUT the Initiative

With the full-scale invasion of Ukraine by Russian troops, there is an urgent need to help Ukrainians survive and fight for their independence. The war has caused military losses and thousands of civilian casualties, millions of refugees and displaced persons, destroyed towns and housing infrastructure, and disrupted supplies of essential goods to occupied or frontline regions.

*The Christians for Ukraine International Initiative*, founded by *the Eastern European Reformation Ministry* in close cooperation with *the Light of God Church* in Lublin, Poland, is a platform for various charitable initiatives to organize humanitarian aid for Ukrainians in Ukraine and Poland.

# Humanitarian HELP

The delivery of humanitarian aid collected by the people of goodwill in Belgium was the beginning of the joint work. 1.5 tons of food, clothing, animal food, etc., were delivered to Ukraine and distributed among 160 needy people in the villages of Lybohora and Tukhlia in the Lviv region.



The next shipment of 20-ton cargo was realized due to cooperation with the Irish, who decided to support Ukraine. An initiative group with the support of the Polish consul in Ireland organizes a regular collection of humanitarian aid. Cargo with clothes and other necessities was sent to *the Youth with a Mission* warehouse in Ternopil, where aid was distributed in various directions in Ukraine.



# Humanitarian HELP

Another batch of aid was organized by our team due to the donations of people who wanted to help Ukraine. We focused on the specific needs in food of people who received help from churches. In March, we sent 3.5 tons to the warehouse of our partner "Youth with a Mission" in Ternopil. From there, aid was sent to Kyiv and the Lviv region, where 350 people received food and other necessities. Currently, funds continue to flow and we plan to make the supply of essential products and goods regular.





We also established cooperation with the Korean Christian organization *Korea Food for the Hungry International (KFHI)*. They wanted to help Ukraine but were looking for reliable channels for distribution. Korean donors have funded the one-week provision with essential goods for 300 adults and 100 children. The aid was delivered to two locations in the Kyiv region.

# Humanitarian HELP

Another consignment of humanitarian aid was the beginning of cooperation between *the Christians for Ukraine initiative* and *the Full Gospel Church (the USA)*. Through joint efforts, up to 10 tons of food and other necessities were purchased and sent to Donetsk, Zhytomyr, Kyiv, Rivne, and Lviv regions. In total, about 1,100 people received help.





# EVACUATION

In addition to the supply of food, household goods, and clothing, together with our partners from *the European Great Commission Collaboration*, we managed to deliver 4 minibusses for the evacuation of people and deliverance of humanitarian aid to different regions of Ukraine. We handed over two minibusses to the team of chaplains from Mariupol, who help to take people out and deliver aid to the front line.

One of the minibusses was used to evacuate people from hot spots in the Kyiv region and Chernihiv. When the need for evacuation decreased, we handed over this bus to *the Christian Rescue Service* chaplains, who are now driving to the frontline areas to deliver essentials for the military.

The fourth bus serves the needs of the Lviv Church that helps migrants.

We continue to develop cooperation to provide volunteers with the necessary vehicles to evacuate people and deliver humanitarian aid.

# Shelters and work with Ukrainians **IN POLAND**

During February and March 2022, 6 shelters for refugees from Ukraine have been opened in Lublin and the region. In addition to material support, volunteers help them solve various issues that may arise. There are special centers at the shelters, where children can have different kinds of classes. We also try to provide spiritual support to people who have been forced to leave the country.

Another shelter is planned to be opened soon.



# Shelters and work with Ukrainians **IN POLAND**

Thanks to the support of patrons, we have purchased a two-story building with a total area of about 600 m<sup>2</sup>. The building has several purposes:

- A house of worship for *the Light of God Church*, which is developing dynamically
- Office of our team
- We plan to open the Ukrainian Christian Center here in the future

This is a very good time for evangelization because many people are ready to hear the Word of God, which gives hope and guides them through difficult situations. We are already seeing a revival in the churches that have responded to the need to help Ukraine.



# Ukrainian **PRAYER BOOK** and dissemination of other literature for evangelism

Due to the hard times throughout the country, there was a need for a tool that could bring hope and help even unbelievers to turn to God in prayer. We have developed a new Ukrainian Prayer Book, which has been published in the amount of 1 million copies with financial support from *Every Home for Christ Ministry*. Half of the circulation was printed in Ukraine, and another half was printed in Poland. We distribute them to the military, refugees, and other people affected by the war.



The Christians for Ukraine initiative also contributed to the dissemination of other evangelistic literature among ministries working in Ukraine.
